




# **CLUSTER 1: OPEN EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES FOR COLLABORATIVE LEARNING**

## **GUIDELINES ON HOW TO CONDUCT COURSES**

This section describes the activities you must complete to finish one or both courses and earn a certificate.

Both courses include analysis of theoretical readings, video watching, and the final self-assessment quizzes. After you conduct all tasks, you will be requested to deliver a final collaborative assignment, questions, and self-assessment quizzes.

At the end of each lesson, you can share your experience and ideas in a discussion forum. Please check the symbols below to help you follow the module's structure.



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## SELF-ASSESSMENT AND FINAL QUIZZES

For consistent learning progress, each lesson ends with a self-assessment quiz that includes 7 multiple-choice. These quizzes are for self-assessment, and scores are not calculated. We recommend taking these quizzes since we might incorporate some of them into the final quiz.

The **final quiz** will help you to self-assess your learning and overall understanding of training content. The final quiz has 15 multiple-choice questions. You can take the quiz as many times as you need to.

To earn a **Certificate of Attendance**, you must score at least 12 out of 15 points (80% of total points).

To earn a **Certificate of Achievement**, you will need to complete a self-assessment quiz (score with at least 12 points, 80%, of total points) and deliver the final collaborative assignment (described below) in the form of an OER.

#### FINAL COLLABORATIVE ASSIGNMENT

The final assignment in this cluster is **to create an OER in collaboration with other course participants**.

The assignment is to create an OER in the scope of 1000 words.

A more detailed task description is presented in a separate document "Description of a Final Collaborative Assignment" (below).

## **CERTIFICATES**

Two types of certificates can be issued at the end of the course:

Certificate of Attendance	This certificate confirms that the student has <i>taken the</i> course, studied the course material, and passed the final quiz with a minimum score of 80%.
Certificate of Achievement	This certificate confirms that the student has <i>completed</i> the <i>final quiz</i> with a minimum score of 80% and <i>completed the final collaborative assignment</i> .
